



Getting Started Guide

A quick reference to making the most of your yourlist.org experience

Log On

You are bursting with ideas for how to change America...Awesome! But first, you'll have to create a quick profile and log in to the site. You can either create a new profile through yourlist or use your Facebook info to get started.

Starting your list

Once you log on, you will be redirected to 'MyHome' where you can create your list in 3 quick steps:

1. Type your issue then press **"+ Add"** (Note: You can add multiple issues here.)
2. Once you're done adding all your issues, press the **"Process List"** button. You'll be asked if any of the items on your list are similar to issues other users have identified. Each issue will also be categorized automatically (Note: 'TBD' category means that the yourlist team will do this manually before the next time you log on.)
3. Press **"Finalize"** to complete your list

Exploring yourlist.org

Once you've created your list, you're ready to explore... Here are some exciting features to check out:

- ➔ **MyHome:** Once you've logged in, MyHome is your starting point - you can view your list, see your friends, track political reps, follow groups or see how popular your issues are in your community and across the country.
- ➔ **Issue Home page:** Click on an issue to visit the 'Issue Home Page' where you can see other users who have identified the same issue or start a community forum to discuss relevant topics.
- ➔ **Category Home page:** Every issue is attached to a category (i.e. "Fix a pothole on my street" is in the 'Infrastructure' Category). You can visit a category home page to see all the issues that have been identified in this group.
- ➔ **User Home page:** On the Community Page, or Issue/Category Home pages you can click a user's name to see their checklist or add them as a friend.
- ➔ **Community page:** Hear video lists from users around the country, see featured lists and the most popular issues at any given time on the Community Page. You can also see which zip codes across the country are most vocal.
- ➔ **Search page:** The search page is a powerful tool that allows you to look for specific issues, users, categories, etc. You can also refine your search or redirect to a user or issue home page.

You're now ready to take the first step to making your voice heard and redefining how we do democracy in this country! Make sure to share yourlist.org with your friends. Enjoy!
